

MAINTENANCE

The following User Tips will help you extend the life and performance of your Brooks Barrel Lock Key.

- The key is an instrument, not a tool. Rough handling or abuse can damage they key fingers and prevent them from mating with the barrel lock plunger.
- You will often sense an "click" when the fingers have properly engaged the barrel lock plunger. A slight turn of the handle will assure that proper engagement occurs.
- If a key fails to open the barrel lock the first time, remove the key and reinsert.
 DO NOT FORCE THE KEY OR JAM INTO THE LOCK. If you suspect the keyway is blocked, use a Brooks Barrel Lock Cleaning Tool to remove the dirt. Try the key again.
- Keep the protective cover on the key when not in use. There is a reaming tool at the bottom of the cover. Twist the key within the protective cover occasionally to clean the tip.
- Periodically inspect your key for worn or bent fingers. Clean the key with a toothbrush to remove dirt and other material that can collect on and under the key fingers.
- Do not use lubricant on keys or barrel locks. LPS-1, a non lubricating cleaner for electronics, is OK.
- Always install a plastic weather cap on the head of the barrel lock, or a plastic cap
 on the seal adapter to keep dirt and insects out of the barrel lock keyway.

Barrel Lock Puller Clamshell style puller grips tightly around the head to remove troubled locks
